Do You Know Someone with Autism?

The UC Irvine Center for Autism Research and Translation (CART) and Dr. John Jay Gargus are seeking research subjects with a diagnosis of autism, their siblings and parents, and non-autistic individuals. The purpose of this study is to learn more about the causes of autism and the causes responsible for the differences between autistic individuals and their unaffected family members.

Research subjects will participate in comprehensive autism screening tests that include the following: ADOS test, WASI/Mullen IQ test, blood laboratory panels, skin biopsy, genomic sequencing, EEG, breath and saliva analysis, and a sleep study. The total time commitment for subjects is approximately 12 hours and 1-2 clinic visits. Compensation for participation is \$160 for study completion.

You may be eligible for participation in this study if: (1) You have a diagnosis of autism (and are 2-65 years old) (2) You have a child or sibling with a diagnosis of autism (3) You are unaffected (and are 7-17 years old) (4) You are English-speaking
